November 30, 2025, First Sunday of Advent:

Grades of Prayer – 8. Prayer of Confirming Union – Definition and Characteristics

St. Teresa of Avila, in *The Interior Castle*, describes **three stages of mystical prayer: the Prayer of Union** (fifth mansion), **the Prayer of Confirming Union**—also known as spiritual betrothal or ecstatic union (sixth mansion)—and **the Prayer of Transforming Union**, also known as spiritual marriage or rapture (seventh mansion). Although these three stages are all forms of mystical prayer, there are important distinctions among them. Last week, we reflected on **the Prayer of Union**, in which the soul experiences a certitude of God's presence and divine reality with such intensity that it may easily fall into ecstasy. **The Prayer of Union progresses into the Prayer of Confirming Union**, in which the human will joyfully, generously, and willingly aligns itself with God's will. **The Prayer of Transforming Union is the highest level of perfection**, where the soul becomes truly "transformed" into God by grace.

St. Teresa teaches that in these final stages of prayer, God gradually captivates all the faculties of the human person: first, the will (Prayer of Union); second, all the interior faculties of the soul—intellect, will, memory, and imagination—as well as the external senses (Prayer of Confirming Union); and finally, at the highest level, the entire person is captivated by God, and the soul is moved to a deeper knowledge of Him (Prayer of Transforming Union). Let us now reflect on the nature and effects of the Prayer of Confirming Union. St. Teresa states that in **the Prayer of Confirming Union**, God captivates even the external senses, with the result that the soul becomes, so to speak, divinized and prepared for the full and final commitment of the Transforming Union. In this state, the soul loses the use of its external senses, either partially or totally, because all its interior faculties are absorbed in God and the senses are drawn away from their natural operations. It becomes difficult for the soul to turn its attention to external activity, though it knows that at times it must "leave God for God" in fulfilling its duties or acts of charity. Yet the predominant sentiment of such souls is a longing for full and perfect union with God, often accompanied by a yearning for death, understood as the passage into complete communion with Him.

St. John of the Cross teaches that in the ecstatic experience of the Confirming Union, God's Spirit consumes the soul. The soul not only encounters God in the deepest center of its being, but at times seems to peer into the very essence of God and to perceive divine mysteries, so profoundly that it feels as though it has been transported into another world.

As we begin the season of Advent, the Church places before our eyes the holy men and women of Scripture who eagerly awaited the Messiah. In the liturgical texts and readings, we can sense their "spirit of longing and expectation, filled with hope and joy" for His coming. During this Advent season, may we continue to grow in our life of prayer, which deepens our longing and desire for union with God. May this season fill your hearts with a spirit of longing and a desire for greater perfection in charity. — Fr. Jesu

Do you Need Sacraments?

For all your Sacramental needs call the church office, fill out necessary forms, and make an appointment with the priest, take Sacramental preparation classes. Do not set a date for a celebration without consulting the priest, and taking necessary classes for the Sacraments.

Baptisms: Please contact the church office at least three months prior to setting a date as a pre-baptismal meeting is required.

Marriage: Please contact the church office to visit with your priest at least six months before setting a date as premarital classes must be attended prior to the wedding.

For both of these sacraments you must be a member of our Parish and in good standing. If you belong to another Parish and are seeking the Sacraments in our parish, you must bring a letter from your priest.

¿Necesitas Sacramentos?

Para todas sus necesidades sacramentales, llame a la oficina parroquial, llene los formularios necesarios y haga una cita con el sacerdote, y tome las clases de preparación sacramental. Bautizos: Se debe contactar a la oficina al menos un mes antes de la fecha de celebración. Una reunión pre-bautismal es necesario antes de configurar la fecha.

Matrimonio: el padre debe ser contactado durante al menos seis meses antes de la boda. Recuerda tomar clases antes de fijar la fecha.

Para ambos sacramentos debe ser miembro de nuestra parroquia y estar en buena posición. **Si perteneces a otra parroquia y deseas recibir los Sacramentos en nuestra parroquia, debes traer una carta de tu párroco.**

Quinceañera: Si está planeando un quinceañera, asegúrese de comunicarse primero con la oficina de la iglesia, antes de fijar una fecha.

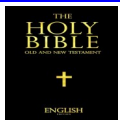

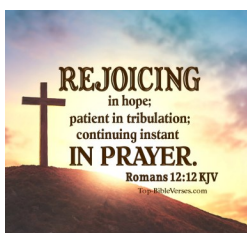

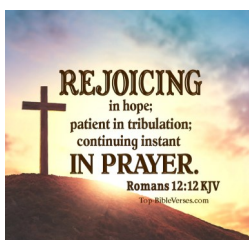
