

### **Saint of the Week: St. Francis de Sales Feast January 24**

**St. Francis De Sales** (Aug 21, 1567-Dec 28, 1622). He was canonized in 1665 by Pope Alexander VII. His father Francis was 45 and his mother Frances De Boisy was 15 when they got married. Francis de Sales was the first child and he had 12 siblings. His father wanted his son to study law and politics and pursue political life. But the son wanted to become a priest. As Francis himself says, "I studied law and politics to please my dad. But I studied theology to please God and myself". He studied at the Jesuit college of Clermont in Paris (1580-88) and at Padua, Italy, where he received a doctorate in civil and canon law (1591). After briefly practicing law, he entered the seminary. He was ordained priest on December 8, 1593, at Annecy. He was a gifted man, brilliant intellect, persevering, gentle, affable, irresistibly charming, and above all, consumed with the love of God. As a young priest, he chose to work in the Calvinistic district of Chablais where he faced severe opposition and life threats from the Calvinists. However, he labored alone, with courage, and determination. He produced many "catechetical pamphlets" in which he explained the true doctrines of the Catholic faith. He pushed them under the doors of homes. He ministered to the children with such gentleness. Eventually, the parents who saw his kindness to their children and the people who read his pamphlets began to listen to his preaching. Consequently, he converted 60,000 Calvinist to Catholic faith. On December 8, 1602, he was ordained bishop and became the bishop of Geneva. As a bishop, he worked tirelessly, preached retreats, gave spiritual direction to many people, reformed the clergy, and wrote two classical spiritual books: *Introduction to devout life* (in 1608) and *The Treatise on the Love of God* (in 1616). Then, with the help of St. Jane Frances de Chantal, who was a widow with four children, Francis founded *the Order of Visitation Nuns*. Francis believed and taught that all Christians can live a holy life in whatever state they are called to live. He was a man of integrity, humility, and had a great sense of humor. He always said, *I am a man and nothing if not a man*. King Henry IV said of him, *"A rare bird, this Monsieur de Geneve. He is devout, and learned, but also at the same time a gentleman, a very rare combination*. St. Vincent de Paul praised him, *He so governed the passions of the soul and the movements of reason that not only did he ever preserve same tenor of his way of life, but even his countenance showed no change in prosperous or adverse circumstances*. Today, several religious institutions follow his spirituality, just to mention a few: The Vincentians, the Visitation Nuns, the Salesians of Don Bosco, and the Oblates of St. Francis de Sales. Yes, St. Francis was a gentle soul, a strong hammer that smashed the Calvinism, but through gentle dialogue. He teaches how to evangelize our modern world. Fr. Jesu
