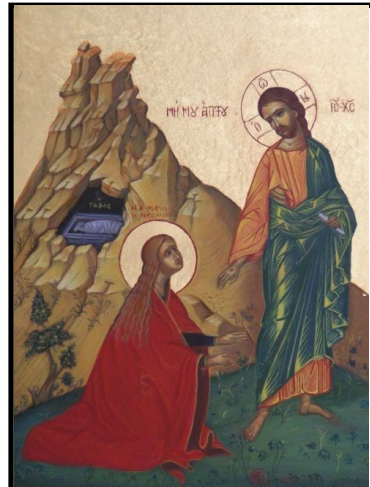

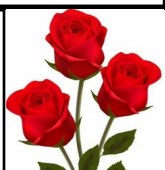


St. Mary Magdalene (July 22)

The gospels mention a few women as close friends, disciples, and benefactors of Jesus. They are Mary and Martha (two sisters of Lazarus) from Bethany (John 11:19, 12:2-4), and Mary Magdalene (Mark 16:9, John 20:1-18). According to the biblical tradition, Mary Magdalene was born in Magdala which is a fishing village on the lake of Tiberias. The word *magdal* in Hebrew / Aramaic means, "Tower". St. Luke presents her and some other women as the helpers and followers of Jesus. **Accompanying him were the Twelve and some women who had been cured of evil spirits and infirmities, Mary, called Magdalene, from whom seven demons had gone out, Joana, the wife of Herod's steward Chuza, Susana, many others who provided for them out of their resources.** (Luke 8,2-3). Some people confuse Mary Magdalene with the sinful woman who washed the feet of Jesus with her tears, wiped them with her hair, and anointed his feet with costly perfume at the house of Pharisee (Luke 7:36-50). But she is an anonymous woman. Mary Magdalene manifests great qualities of courage, tenacity, fervor, and great love for her master, Jesus. She is also known as the **apostle among the apostles** because she accompanied Jesus during his ministry, suffering, crucifixion, and became the first witness of his resurrection, and the empty tomb (Mark 15 & 16, John 19:25-27). The first reading provided for Mass on her feast day is taken from the book of *Song of Songs* (3:1-4), which poetically expresses her thirst and anxious

love for her master, Jesus. Her feast invites us to "seek and love our Master earnestly and truly. The recent movie episodes of *the Chosen*, Season 1, part one presents how Jesus healed her from the demonic possession. Though her exorcism is not described in detail by any of the evangelist, the movie beautifully visualizes the trauma she went through and the grace she received from her savior, Jesus Christ. Let us pray for freedom from all spiritual burdens and demonic influences that we or our family members may suffer from, and let us ask for the spirit of audacity to be witnesses of Jesus. — Fr. Jesu

Sacraments / Sacramentos
Baptisms: Please contact the church office at least three months prior to setting a date as a pre-baptismal meeting is required.
Marriage: Please contact the church office to visit with your pastor at least six months before setting a date as premarital classes must be attended prior to the wedding.
For both of these sacraments you must be a member of our Parish and in good standing. If you belong to another Parish and are seeking the Sacraments you must bring letter from your priest.
