Student Profile: Paul Kayemba

Paul Kayemba is a remarkable man. His life here in the U.S. started as a desire for freedom when he and his family escaped from Uganda during the last two years of the oppressive dictator Idi Amin's regime.

At the University of Michigan, an honors English course required him to read complete books of the Bible including the Pentateuch, Psalms and Matthew. He became involved with Chi Alpha and Intervarsity

Campus fellowships, which sparked a desire in his heart to purposefully evangelize and disciple.

Paul told us: "In 1998 I had a desire to enter a school of ministry, but no avenues appeared to open until a couple of years later when Tim and Beverly Buchholtz planted the UBTC in Tallahassee. I was excited to be part of the first class of students for training in biblical studies. Then later I finished my training with the DSOM. Both UBTC and DSOM offered an encouraging environment equipping students with practical elements of ministry and insightful resources for further biblical study. Combining UBTC/DSOM studies with my more recent studies in English literature and graduate history at Florida A&M University, should serve as good tools for ministry as well as additional graduate studies and continued writing for the Department of Education."



We felt like proud parents this past May as we watched our ministry "son" become an ordained minister with the Assemblies of God.

Paul is currently serving at our church plant, Transforming Life Church, where he teaches and works with our children's outreach ministry.
