Dear West Florida District School of Ministry Student:

Please be aware that the course order for the Certified and License levels (years one and two) is being amended. This may effect which courses you will order next.

While the changes issued from The General Council of the Assemblies of God are effective immediately, our NSOM students are being granted an extension to complete their current level of study providing they intend to apply for their *Certified Minister's* credential no later than August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021. After that deadline, you will have to meet the new ministerial study requirements as outlined below.

This change will not affect those currently in their second level (license level) studies. However, in order to advance to the *License* credential, you must complete all of the second level coursework under the old course order.

If you recently began your ministerial studies with the NSOM, we recommend you enroll in those courses shown under the new order (2021 academic calendar).
