Adult Renewal Application - Canada Download Adult Renewal Form Adult Simplified Renewal Passport Application form (PPTC 054) IMPORTANT NOTICE Due to the impacts of COVID-19, Passport Canada allows people to renew their passport if it has been expired for more than 1 year. Passport Canada indicates that they aren't liable for any monetary losses if they can't deliver the passport in time to you or your child. Passport Canada allows passport holders to renew their adult passport within 1 year after the expiry. However, due to delays caused by COVID-19 restrictions, you are now able to renew your adult passport after 1 year expiry if: You were 16 years of age or older when you applied for your last Canadian passport. You last passport was valid for either 5 or 10 years. You passport expired on or after February 1, 2019.

You are not changing your name, date of birth, place of birth or gender on the new passport. Your current expired passport is not damaged or declared lost or stolen to Passport Canada. (You may renew your passport 1 year before expiry) For any other circumstances, please visit Passport Canada's website to find out your eligibility for renewal. Click here. To renew your passport, you'll need to fill out an application form get your supporting documents and passport photos you will also need 2 references to include on your application. Your references must have known you for at least two years, find out how to submit your application and fees send your old passport with your application (if apply by mail) / if in person, the old passport will be cancelled and cannot be used for travel anymore Include the following documents with your application form: your most recent passport This is so Passport Canada can cancel it. You can't travel with a cancelled passport or travel document. 2 identical passport photos On the back of one of the photos, the photographer must write their name their complete address and the date the photos were taken Read the full photo requirements for more information. You must submit all documents in either English or French. If a document is in another language, you must provide an official translation. How to renew your adult passport in Canada General tips and instructions Passport Canada recommends that you don't finalize any travel plans until you get your passport. The passport renewal form is in PDF fillable format. Please try to complete electronically. The instructions are at the end of the PDF file. Ensure to sign each page of the passport renewal application form. If the term "mother's surname" doesn't apply to you cross it out on the form and write "parent's surname at birth" fill in the field with the surname (last name) at birth of 1 parent write your initials in the margin If your passport has a valid visa in it, please notify on your form if you need the visa and want your original passport back. If you don't, the visa could be damaged when the previous passport is cancelled. Submit your application Application options in Canada If you need your passport in more than 25 business days, you must apply by mail. If you need your passport in 25 business days or less, you may apply in person (by appointment only). Paying your renewal application fees The following fees below are for Canadians who submit their passport applications in Canada, in-person or by mail.

CAN YOU WALK-IN AND RENEW YOUR U.S. PASSPORT?

You can renew by walk-in if you answer 'yes' to ALL 5 statements below about your passport.

1. You have your passport in your possession to submit to a walk-in application.
2. It's undamaged other than normal wear and tear.
3. Was issued when you were age 16 or older.
4. Was issued within the last 15 years.
5. Was issued in your current name or you can document your name change.

If you answered 'NO' to any statement, you must make an appointment.

Receiving your passport If you applied by mail, Passport Canada will return your passport and any original documentation to you. It may arrive in 2 separate packages. If you're moving but haven't received your passport yet Contact Passport Canada to update your mailing address if you: haven't received your passport and are moving within 30 days of submitting your application If you applied in person and paid for a pickup service The pickup date will be indicated on your application receipt. You can appoint another person to pick up your passport if they have valid identification and written authorization from you to do so. Need to renew your Canadian passport? Don't wait for any surprises at the airport - plan ahead and learn about how you can renew your Canadian passport now.

How do I renew my Canadian passport? The process of renewing a Canadian passport can be completed by filling out a simplified form or a full application, depending on the situation. As of early 2023, you can mail in your application or submit your application in person. Starting in the fall of 2023, Canadians will be able to submit their passport applications online. How long does it take to renew my Canadian passport? The processing time for your Canadian passport renewal begins once you submit your completed passport application. When renewing at a passport office, it can take as little as 10 business days to get your renewed passport. If you mail in your application, it should take 20 business days (plus shipping time). However, Canadians should plan for delays and not leave passport renewal to the last minute. Plan to renew your passport at least 2-3 months in advance of travel, just to be safe. How much does Canadian passport renewal cost? As of 2023, a standard five-year passport is \$120 and a 10-year passport is \$160. A child's passport is \$57. Additional fees for expedited services apply. *Post last updated on June 5, 2023 with the latest information on renewing your Canadian passport, according to the Government of Canada website. When does my passport need to be renewed? Many countries require your passport to still be valid for three to six months after you enter the country, so make sure to always check the expiration date before booking a flight. For example, if your passport expires in December 2023, that can mean you need a new passport as of June 2023 or September 2023, depending on your destination. To avoid any last-minute hassles however, it's best to veer on the side of caution and renew your passport if you're getting to the 6-month expiry date. This is especially true if you are planning to enter a country that requires a visa. You will have to renew your Canadian passport before applying for certain visas if your travel document expires in six months or less. As a form of identification, your Canadian passport is valid until the expiry date, which means it needs to be valid upon your return to your originating country - hence the 3 or 6-month rule. How to renew your Canadian Passport in 2023 Whether you are applying for a new Canadian passport or getting your current one renewed, adults are given the choice of a 5 or 10-year passport. Children only have a 5-year option; this goes for all Canadian children from newborns to age 16, according to the Government of Canada website. You can't renew your child's passport. You must get all the documents ready and apply for a new one. Depending on your situation, your Canada passport renewal form will be a simplified form or you will need to apply for a new passport. If you have a 10-year passport, then you will have to renew your Canadian passport before the 10-years expiry date. You should apply for a new Canadian passport if you want to update/change any of the personal information on the document, including: name date of birth place of birth gender identifier Note that Canada does not add pages to your passport which means that if you have collected your fair share of visa stamps and your passport is full, you'll have to apply to renew your passport and pay the fees. In this case, we recommend that the most intrepid of travellers apply for a 5-year passport in lieu of a 10-year passport, to avoid running out of pages in your passport. While the new Canadian passports do have 36 pages, you never know where life may take you. The cost of a standard five-year Canadian passport is \$120 and a 10-year passport is \$160.



A child's passport (0-15 years of age) is \$57. There are additional fees associated with replacing a lost or stolen passport in Canada or abroad as well as for express or urgent processing. Urgent and express service is available only if you apply in person at a Canada passport office (with some exceptions). Methods of payment accepted for your passport include: credit card or prepaid card debit card money order or certified cheques (the exact amount in Canadian funds, made payable to the "Receiver General of Canada"). Please note that passport fees are higher if you are located outside of Canada. Payments accepted include debit cards, credit cards, money orders, and certified cheques. The Canadian passport processing time begins once you submit a complete passport application. The renewal time for your Canadian passport depends if you are renewing at a passport office or by mail. When renewing at a passport office in Canada, it usually takes 10 business days to get your renewed passport. Renewing in person at Canada Post and Service Canada will take about 20 business days. If you mail in your application, it should take 20 business days.

This does not include mailing time. Some Canadian passport renewal locations have urgent and express service if you need it quickly (for an extra fee). Check before you go to see if this option is available and make sure to bring proof of travel if you need to request urgent service. These additional fees are on top of the regular Canadian passport fees. Proof of need or travel is required if an in-person appointment is provided. It is easy to renew your Canadian passport with the adult simplified renewal passport application. In order to qualify, there are a few criteria you need to meet. You are eligible for passport renewal if your passport: was an adult passport that was issued was valid for 5 or 10 years has the same name, date of birth, and place of birth as you want on your new passport has the same gender identifier that you want on your new passport can be printed on your most recent passport or have the observation sticker. Note: In previous years, the guideline was that damaged passports were not accepted for renewal. However, this is no longer the case for Canadians in 2023! If your passport has seen all kinds of adventures, don't worry because you can get it renewed. For the adult simplified passport renewal, you need to complete the simplified version of the Canadian passport application form, which can be downloaded via the Government of Canada's website. Just fill out the information online, print out the form, sign it, and bring it to your nearest passport location or mail it in with the necessary documents. You will also need your most recent passport, the processing fee, and two recent identical photos (more details on this below). You will also need to have two personal references on your renewal form. These references cannot be family members and must have known you for 2 years or more. If you are not eligible for the simplified passport renewal, you need to fill out the general application form.

In addition to the general Canadian passport form, you are required to provide your birth certificate or proof of citizenship and include your existing passport or related travel documents with the application. The general adult form requires a signature from a guarantor. This is a friend or family member who will certify that you are being truthful on your application. The requirements for an eligible guarantor are: be 18 years of age or older Canadian Citizen have known you for at least 2 years for passport applications 6 months for certificate of identity and refugee travel document applications agree to you using their name and contact information for your application. When applying for your new Canadian passport, make sure your contacts are available and easy to get a hold of - that's one phone call you don't want to miss. If you do not have a guarantor, you need to obtain a Declaration in Lieu of Guarantor form from your local passport office (cannot be downloaded online). How to renew your Canadian passport In Canada, passport renewals can typically be done in person at an authorized receiving agent or a passport office. Authorized receiving agents are Canada Post or Service Canada locations. Applications can also be submitted by mail. *Starting in the Fall of 2023, Canadians will be able to submit their passport applications online. You can check here to see if you should mail in your passport application or request an in-person appointment (this will depend on your situation). If you are currently in the United States: Government of Canada consular offices in the United States do not provide regular passport services for Canadians visiting or living in the United States, so you must send in your application by mail or come back to Canada to apply. If you need a passport urgently or in exceptional circumstances such as illness and death, you can contact the nearest Government of Canada passport issuing office abroad. Additional fees will apply. If you are outside Canada and the United States: If you are renewing your passport from outside Canada and the United States, you need to complete the simplified version of the Canadian passport application form which can be downloaded via the Government of Canada's website. Fill out the information online, print out the form, sign it, and bring it to your nearest Canadian Consular Office. You will also need your most recent passport, the processing fee, and two recent identical photos. It's always preferable to go to a shop that specializes in passport photos when renewing your passport. You will need two identical photos for your passport application. Each passport photo must be taken by a commercial photographer or at a retail location, such as Shoppers Drug Mart (or Pharmaprix if you're in Quebec), which offers passport photo services. Passport photos should show your face and shoulders. Eyes must be open, and the expression must be neutral. The back of one of the photos must have the date it was taken as well as the information of the photographer or studio. The photos need to be recent, and taken within at least six months of submitting your application. Can you renew your Canadian passport online? No, application forms to renew your Canadian passport are online but you must bring them to your nearest passport office or send it in via mail. However, beginning in the fall of 2023, passport renewal will be available online. How soon can you renew a Canadian passport? As long as you meet the eligibility requirements you can apply to renew your passport anytime before it expires. As many countries require your passport to be valid for 3-6 months after you enter, it's a good idea to renew your passport at least 6 months before it expires. How long after my Canadian passport expires can I apply to renew it? As per the latest government guidance in 2023, Canadians can renew their passport up to 15 years of its expiry date.
