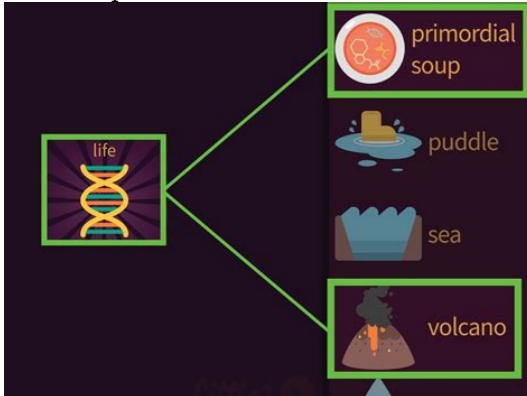

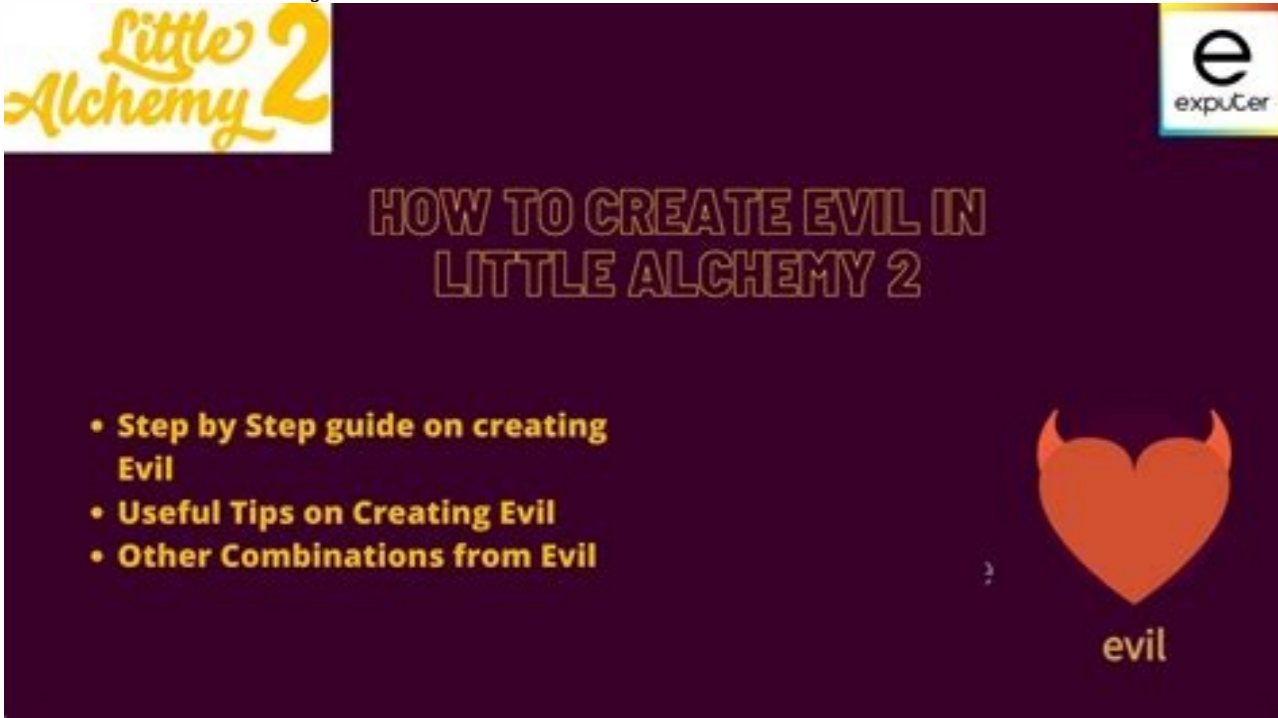
Each step will look at the individual crafting procedure of the pair of main ingredients that make the Force Knight. 1.
