PERSONAL PROFILE

I am a Health and Care Professions Council (HCPC) registered Practitioner (Clinical) Psychologist, and my specialist field is in clinical neuropsychology, particularly traumatic brain injury. I have experience across acute medical, inpatient neurorehabilitation, and community neurorehabilitation settings, and I have completed post-doctoral specialist training in clinical neuropsychology (the PGDip 'Knowledge' component). I am now undertaking the final 'Practice' element of my training in order to gain eligibility for entry on the Specialist Register of Clinical Neuropsychologists (SRCN), which is the gold-standard for clinical neuropsychology expertise in the UK. My clinical work routinely involves undertaking neuropsychological assessments to inform neurorehabilitation of patients with difficulties ranging from mild to severe. In addition, my role includes development of care plans for management of behaviours that challenge, training and supervision of other professionals including support workers, and complex capacity assessments on a range of matters, including health, welfare, finances, and litigation. I remain research active and contribute to the academic literature which supports clinical neuropsychologists.
