I am a passionate and empathetic Clinical Psychologist (specialising in Clinical Neuropsychology) and Health and Care Professions Council (HCPC) registered Practitioner Psychologist. Currently, I work in the NHS for Adult Neuropsychology and Stroke Early Supported Discharge services, within the North Yorkshire area. In this role I work across inpatient, outpatient, and community settings, supporting individuals with a myriad of acquired and degenerative neurological conditions through detailed cognitive assessment, risk management, and therapeutic work, drawing on ACT, CBT, and Systemic Therapy models. I also provide supervision and consultation on care provision to the wider multidisciplinary team. Additional responsibilities include my role as Research Lead for the Neuropsychology service; remaining active on research panels, supervising doctoral students, and lecturing at Teesside University (topics taught include Neuropsychology, Functional Neurological Disorder, Qualitative Systematic Reviews, Equality, Diversity and Inclusion).

I am undertaking the combined knowledge and practice Clinical Neuropsychology MSc training programme at the University of Glasgow which is the gold standard for professional training in the UK and will confer eligibility to join the BPS Specialist Register of Clinical Neuropsychologists once complete.
