#### PERSONAL PROFILE

I am a Clinical Psychologist and registered Health Care and Professions Council (HCPC) Practitioner Psychologist, specialising in Neuropsychology. Since qualifying, I have worked primarily within hospital settings, supporting patients with complex health needs secondary to a range of acquired and degenerative neurological conditions, including traumatic brain injury (mild and moderate-severe).

I currently hold an NHS role in a Neuropsychology outpatient service. My role involves providing therapeutic support and conducting comprehensive neuropsychological assessments for individuals living with a wide range of neurological conditions. I provide detailed neuropsychological reports which assist medical colleagues with differential diagnosis where appropriate and provide tailored recommendations to support an individual's cognitive functioning and psychological wellbeing. Therapeutically, I work closely with allied healthcare professionals within a dynamic multi-disciplinary team, and primarily draw on principles of Compassion Focused Therapy and Acceptance and Commitment Therapy. I have a working knowledge of the Mental Capacity Act 2005 as applied to people with neurological conditions.

Alongside my NHS role, I am passionate about research and teaching. Across the 2023/24 and 2024/25 academic years, I lectured at the University of York and was responsible for teaching on the Clinical Psychology advanced modules (modules included 'Applications of CBT' and 'Professional issues in Clinical Psychology'). I am in the process of pursuing publication for my doctoral thesis, and I am currently supervising doctoral research. I am currently undertaking the Postgraduate Diploma for Clinical Neuropsychology in September 2024 to further my knowledge and expertise in Clinical Neuropsychology.
