I am a Health Care Professions Council (HCPC) registered practitioner (clinical) psychologist, with three year of post-qualification experience in inpatient, outpatient and community neuropsychology services. In these roles I have utilised my skills and knowledge to support people affected by traumatic brain injury, as well as other neurological conditions. I have undertaken further training in clinical neuropsychology following the completion of the Doctorate in Clinical Psychology. I am experienced in neuropsychological assessment, formulation of presenting difficulties, the development of rehabilitation interventions and risk management in multidisciplinary teams. My work involves regular application of the Mental Capacity Act. My work regularly involves systemic working with the networks of people around those affected by brain injury and other neurological conditions. I support people with adjustment to brain injury as well as physical and psychological trauma using various therapeutic approaches, including cognitive behavioural therapy and acceptance and commitment therapy. I supervise trainee clinical psychologists in their roles in neuropsychology services and have lectured on stroke, applied psychometrics and cognitive assessment on the Doctorate in Clinical Psychology at Newcastle University.
