PERSONAL PROFILE

I am a Senior Clinical Psychologist, and Health Care Professions Council (HCPC) registered Practitioner (Clinical) Psychologist, and my specialist field is clinical neuropsychology (adults). I am experienced in working with people who are living with traumatic brain injury (mild, moderate and severe), stroke, functional neurological disorders, and a range of neurodegenerative conditions, who may be experiencing cognitive, emotional and behavioural difficulties.

My work involves comprehensive neuropsychological assessment to inform rehabilitation and therapeutic intervention, and psychological therapy to support with emotional adjustment to living with a neurological condition. I draw upon a range of evidence-based models, including Acceptance and Commitment Therapy (ACT) and Compassion Focused Therapy (CFT). I have undertaken specialist training in the Empowerment Behavioural Management Approach, which is an innovative, person-centred and collaborative approach to managing behavioural difficulties, particularly following acquired brain injury. In my day-to-day role I assess and manage the risks associated with brain injury and illness, contribute to care planning, and in my private practice I conduct mental capacity assessments as required and can provide training and supervision to MDT clinicians and support staff on complex cases.

In addition to direct clinical work, I provide supervision to trainee clinical psychologists on placement and regularly offer neuropsychology consultation to qualified clinicians from a range of disciplines. I am passionate about the role of interdisciplinary working in providing the highest quality care and achieving the best possible outcomes for the people I work with.

Alongside clinical practice, I am currently studying the PgDip Applied Clinical Neuropsychology at Glasgow University, working towards eligibility for the Specialist Register of Clinical Neuropsychologists.
