I am a Consultant Clinical Neuropsychologist with dual registration as a Practitioner Clinical Psychologist on the Health and Care Professions Council (HCPC) and the Specialist Register of Clinical Neuropsychologists (SRCN) of the British Psychological Society which is gold standard for the profession. I completed my post-doctoral training at the University of Nottingham. My experiences span the UK and Middle East across inpatient, outpatient and community settings.

I am experienced in assessing and treating traumatic brain injury, from mild to severe, in the community, involving clinical leadership as part of a multidisciplinary team. I undertake complex capacity assessments, and provide support, training, and supervision to clinical and care teams. I have broader extensive experience working with adults across the lifespan with a range of other neurological conditions including epilepsy, stroke, dementia and multiple sclerosis. I also have a background in learning disability.

Previously, I contributed to the United Arab Emirates first dedicated stroke inpatient unit by establishing neuropsychology as a core clinical component, integrating cognitive and psychological care into the acute stroke pathway.

I have a special interest in spiritually-integrated and culturally appropriate psychotherapy. I am currently undertaking private practice as a treating clinician in clinical neuropsychology and concomitantly within a specialist faith-based, and culturally appropriate mental health organization in the third sector, providing holistic support to diverse client groups.
