My passion and main focus is Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (CBT), where I specialise in treating psychological trauma and anxiety disorders. This includes extensive experience working with conditions such as Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) following lifechanging events and injuries, for which Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (TF-CBT) is the NICE recommended first line treatment, and has a strong evidence base for effectiveness. I also routinely work clinically with Panic Disorder, Generalised Anxiety Disorder (GAD), Health Anxiety, Obsessive-Compulsive Disorder (OCD), and Social Anxiety.

My approach is deeply person-centred, emphasizing compassion, empathy, and a warm therapeutic relationship. I believe that effective mental health treatment begins with understanding each client's unique experience and needs. My private practice allows me to deliver highly personalised care, drawing on my experience and deep understanding of CBT. I am committed to staying current with the latest research and best practices, regularly engaging in professional development to ensure that my clients receive the most effective treatment available.

During my time in the police force and prison services, I developed a robust understanding of the complex interplay between mental health, substance misuse, and contact with the criminal justice system. This experience shaped my ability to work effectively with individuals facing significant challenges, using a holistic approach to support recovery and stability. Transitioning to community mental health nursing expanded my expertise, allowing me to work with a broad range of clients dealing with severe and chronic mental health conditions. My role included direct patient care, crisis intervention, and the coordination of multidisciplinary teams to provide comprehensive support. This experience enhanced my skills in risk assessment and the development of tailored multidisciplinary care plans, ensuring that each client received the support they needed. In addition to my current clinical work in CBT, I am passionate about teaching and have extensive experience educating medical students about psychiatry with a special interest in teaching CBT. I find great fulfilment in mentoring future mental health professionals, helping them to develop the skills and knowledge required to excel in their careers.
