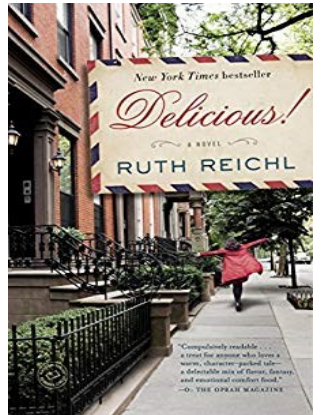

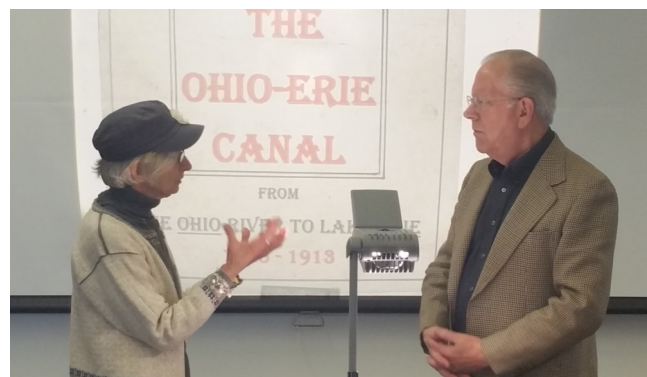

### *Say Yes to Less Stress*

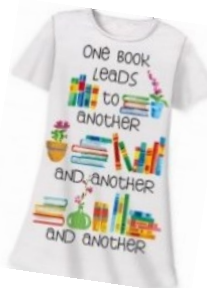
