# Friends and Library Sign MoU

In October the Friends of the Library (Main) and the Stark Library signed a Memorandum of Understanding that details how the two entities will work together to support the mission and goals of the Library. Together we hope to fulfill our commitment to the community and patrons we serve." We appreciate the joint effort in completing this important agreement and look forward to transforming our community together."
