



OVERALL GOAL – “One-way trick-or-treating where individually wrapped goodies are lined up for families to grab and go.”

1. **PARKING** – A designated sign will be placed where you will park during the event. Your trunk is to be facing the inside of the square. MABA will provide an assigned space with signage before you arrive.
2. **VEHICLE TRUNKS** – So each parent is aware of who they are receiving their children’s candies, please provide a Business Sign/Vehicle Sign with your business logo/name. We will provide a temporary sign for parking purposes.
3. **TREATS** – Please decorate your truck as in the past. Only prepackaged candies, little favors, or treat bags (no homemade treats) for safe easy distribution.
4. **FOOT TRAFFIC** – Event coordinators will provide arrows to direct foot traffic and keep people walking in one direction during the event.

There was a great turnout last year! I would plan on 400+ pieces of candy to pass out to our Trick-or-Treaters. Any leftovers, you’ll still have time to use them at your own home on Halloween night.
