



COOPER-GODLOVE CPIC AWARDS OF EXCELLENCE

The Capital Planning Professional (CPP) certification was developed by the FitGovSummit and Certification Special Interest Group. The purpose of the certification is to provide a formal level of distinction for the best and brightest subject matter experts in the field of federal capital planning and investment control. In addition, it also acknowledges individuals who share the same combination of professional ethics, knowledge and experience that are the hallmarks of excellence within the profession. The FitGovSummit will provide for the administration of the CPP, which will include independent verification and validation of references and content of applications, approvals, and certification of appropriate applicants, denials of certification (when appropriate) and management tracking of certified CPP members. 
