FURTHERMORE, encourage our citizens to take time to honor veterans by participating in local ceremonies to include a memorial service on Saturday, November 9, 2024 in the Veteran's Memorial Park beginning at 11:00 a.m. .

WHEREAS, the central philosophy of home care care puts patients first, ensuring a coordinated and person-centered approach to care, protecting patient choice and access to individualized services based on a patient's unique care needs and wishes.



The following are activities that are or will be involving our department this month.

<u>Flag Football</u> – Our third season of Flag Football "Kicked Off" on Wednesday, October 30<sup>th</sup> with 105 participants in three different age groups.

The leagues are playing games at Civitan Park and the Browder Park facilities. Weather permitting we should conclude regular season and tournament play around December 5<sup>th</sup>.

<u>Girls' Volleyball</u> – This program began its eleventh season Monday, November 4<sup>th</sup> with one hundred and fifty young ladies participating in three different age groups. This program continues to grow as that number represents an approximate 5% increase from last year's enrollment. All games are played at Browder Park.

Youth Basketball – Registration for this program began Wednesday, November 13<sup>th</sup>.

<u>Election Day</u> – Browder Park will once again be a polling precinct on Tuesday, November 5<sup>th</sup>.

<u>Browder Park Renovations</u> – Work is proceeding accordingly on both the concession stand and swimming pool. At the current pace completion should be around the first part of December.
