

Autumn Ball Dress Code & Code of Conduct

Gentleman:

- Dress slacks
- Collared button-down shirt
- Dress shoes
- Tie
- Jacket, sweater or ¼ zip is encouraged, but not required

Ladies:

- Semi-formal or formal dress
- Length can be no shorter than 3 inches from the top of the knee
- Necklines must be modest, with no exposed cleavage
- Strapless dresses are not permitted
- Spaghetti straps are permitted with a modest neckline
- *Ladies are permitted to wear bolero jackets, sweaters or wraps during the dance if necessary to meet these requirements*
- Style Considerations:
 - Cutouts and two-piece dresses, even if connected with sheer fabric are unacceptable
 - Slits in long dresses may not extend higher than 3 inches above the knee
 - No exposed midriffs
 - Careful attention should be paid to the fit of the dress. Dresses should be complimentary fitting
 - The back of the dress should not extend below the midback

Code of Conduct:

Students are to be respectful to each other, the chaperones and the property at all times. Students are not permitted to leave the property and return to the dance. Once a student has exited the dance, they will not be readmitted. Students are to clean up after themselves at the conclusion of the dance, ensuring all trash is properly disposed of in trash cans.

I agree to the above dress code and code of conduct. I understand that if I arrive at the Autumn Ball in attire that does not meet the dress code as outlined above, I will not be permitted into the dance and I will not be issued a refund.
