

## *Prom Dress Code*

Gentleman:

- Dress slacks
- Collared button-down shirt
- Dress shoes
- Tie
- Jacket
- Tuxedo is permitted and encouraged

Ladies:

- Semi-formal or formal dress
- Length can be no shorter than 3 inches from the top of the knee
- Necklines must be modest, with no exposed cleavage
- Strapless dresses are not permitted
- Single shoulder is permitted with a modest neckline
- Spaghetti straps are permitted with a modest neckline
- *Ladies are permitted to wear bolero jackets, sweaters or wraps during the dance if necessary to meet these requirements*
- Style Considerations:
- Cutouts and two-piece dresses, even if connected with sheer fabric are unacceptable
- Slits in long dresses may not be extended higher than your fingertips when hands are down by your side
- No exposed midriffs
- Careful attention should be paid to the fit of the dress. Dresses should be complimentary fitting
- The back of the dress may not be extended below the mid back

## *Prom Code of Conduct*

All participants will treat each other with respect, abide by the dress code, and follow instructions from the chaperones at each event. Once a participant leaves the event property they will not be allowed to return.

## *Agreement*

By purchasing a ticket, I agree with the above dress code and code of conduct. I understand that if I arrive at the Prom in attire that does not meet the dress code as outlined above, I will not be permitted into the dance and I will not be issued a refund.
