Emails

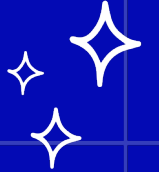
Teachers are given parent and student emails when provided. If you would like your student to take more responsibility for their academics, make sure we are notified of their email address

We will be issuing report cards quarterly, as opposed to by semester

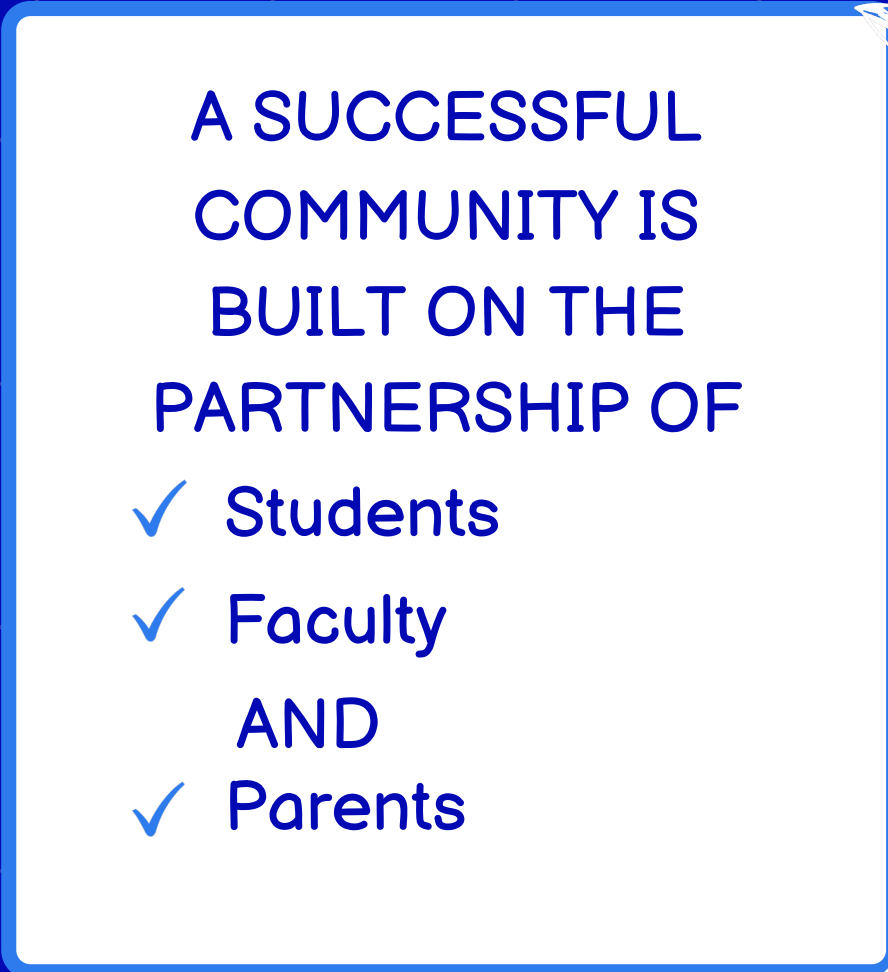

Tuition

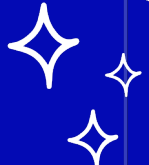
