My Gurukul Journey - A Story of Growth & Gratitude



My journey with Gurukul began on April 15, 2017, marking a new chapter in my life. However, my connection with Gurukul started a year earlier, on April 15, 2016, when I enrolled as the first student in the Cutting & Tailoring course of USHA. This six-month course, which concluded in December 2016, followed my completion of the 12th grade from the CBSE board.

Initially, pursuing a course in cutting and tailoring seemed an unlikely choice for someone academically inclined. Many questioned my decision, suggesting I should aim higher. However, my family's financial constraints required practical choices, and I wanted to make my mother proud. My mother, despite societal constraints, excelled in cutting and tailoring, and I aimed to follow in her footsteps.

During the course, I faced challenges but persisted, thanks to the support of my trainers, Rupa Ma'am and Sudha Ma'am. My efforts paid off when I received the Student of the Year award at Gurukul's first annual event in December 2016. This recognition filled me with immense pride and reaffirmed my decision to be a part of Gurukul.

In early 2017, I started an internship at Gurukul, assisting students and preparing course materials. Soon after, Anuj Bhaiya offered me the position of English trainer. Although my spoken English needed improvement, I embraced the opportunity and enrolled in two spoken English classes. The hard work paid off, and on April 15, 2017, I officially joined Gurukul as an English trainer with a monthly salary of 5,000 rupees.

The transition from student to teacher was challenging but rewarding. I found inspiration in my mother's resilience and determination, which helped me overcome obstacles. Over the past seven years, my role at Gurukul has evolved. I have taken on various positions, from English and personality development trainer to computer, accounts, tally, and CA trainer. Eventually, I became the Project Officer of Gurukul after its partnership with Ambuja Foundation. Witnessing Gurukul's growth from a single hall to a sprawling institute has been a remarkable journey that mirrors my own development.

Gurukul is more than a workplace; it is my second home. The institution has taught me the importance of having a grand vision and the transient nature of difficult times. Each month brings new learnings, and I approach my work with the dedication and love of a family member.

Deepest gratitude to Shri Shipra Rathi Ma'am, Shri Manoj Agarwal Sir, and Shri Vishnu Prasad Sir for guiding me throughout this journey. I have been able to grow and learn with their mentorship and guidance throughout this time. Gurukul: This is not just an office; it is my home.
