As a part of our ongoing efforts to upgrade our faculty, our mobilizers participated in the MET- Mobilization Enhancement Team Meeting, organized by ACF at Agoocha, Bhilwara (Rajasthan) for reshaping and adopting new strategies in students mobilization. Progressing towards a digitalized platform we have also shifted our entire MIS database on the Online SEDI Portal. All the team members of Gurukul in two groups (Basic & Intermediate) are taking a 6 month Spoken & Written English training from SUPER 30 Kolkata. Super 30, a NGO initiative of Mrs Karuna Kajaria which focuses on skilling candidates enabling them to align with their potential. 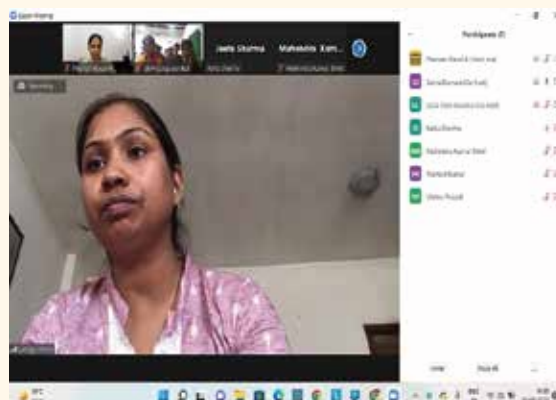


Sessions Organised

Whereas on the 2 day she taught trainees about thermo pack, with this, a 1 hour online session on makeup was also organised. Ma'am ended the session by sharing tips and tricks regarding makeup.
