Handset Repair Engineer is Responsible for performing handset repair including hardware and software components, testing the handset for adequacy post repair and maintaining inventory levels of the hardware components. This trade in the current era is found to be prominent as electronic gadgets are more essential for the use in the daily life.

The training to the trainees is provided under TSSC sub-sector Handset Repairing Engineer Level-2. The training is provided according to the National Occupation Standard (NOS) mentioned by TSSC. The certificate provided by the TSSC is very beneficial and valuable as it can easily take up and help any trainee in entering a gadgeted company or service centre.

To provide the training of this particular trade, a Certified TSSC Trainer Mr. Mani Sharma has been appointed who has completed his Post Graduation in Master of Arts from English and has a experience of more than 4 Years in the training sector.


