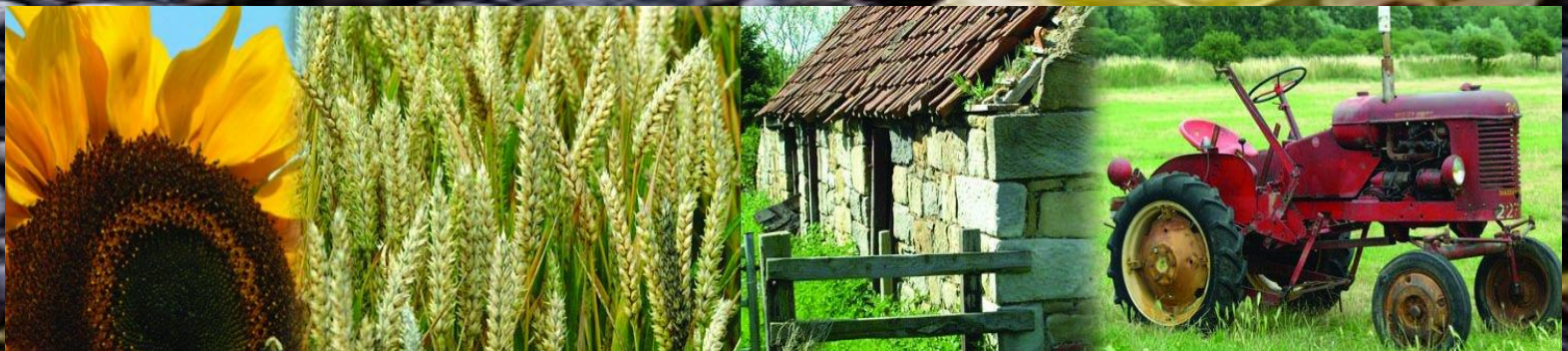

- Goal & Objectives of CAO -

To improve the profitability of the agriculture and food industry in New York State.

- * Strengthen working relationships between all sectors of the industry (commodity sectors, support services, processing, retail and wholesale) and between the industry and government.
- * Improve the business climate for agriculture - reduce regulatory burdens and taxes, assure adequate support services and a trained labor force.
- * Develop markets by building on our advantages - close proximity to markets (large, urban consumer centers, areas of urban sprawl/tourism routes) and hubs of global trade.
- * Position members of the industry so they can adapt to change - economic, technological, marketplace (i.e. consumer demand) and environmental.
- * Enhance research (targeted to NY conditions, biotechnology) and assure an effective mechanism to transfer the information to end user.
- * Increase public awareness of the industry and improve agriculture's image with the non-farm sector. Identify those issues or matters where a coalition with the public can be developed.
