Teachers implement curriculums and materials in the classroom that support these ideas by allowing children the opportunity to play and explore.

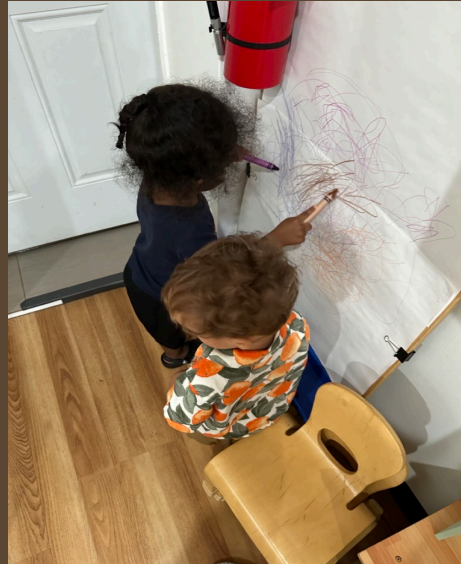
We embrace the uniqueness of each child and nourish their development individually and within the social expectancies through group activities.
