B.A.I.R.D One Year Evidence Based & Clinical Dental Implant Course

This is a nine module intensive implant course which meets the General Dental Council-UK requirement in implant training in Britain and qualifies the course delegates to gain accredited 160 CPD hours by the BAIRD Academy upon finishing the course academic and clinical requirements in addition to the course certificate by the British Academy upon passing the course written exam.

The course modules will take place on one Friday, Saturday and Sunday of each month.
