

Low Voltage Lighting Maintenance Agreement

A Service Tech will come out to your property twice a year during normal working hours – once in the Summer and once in the Winter. Exact dates are at the discretion of the contractor unless the client calls for an appointment. Technician must have access to indoor transformers.

Term:	One year from the date of this agreement. Contract will automatically renew unless cancelled by client.
Agreement In	cludes: - Check all fixtures for proper working order, and repair or replace if necessary with customer's approval (i.e.: bulbs, stakes, lenses, fixtures, etc.) - Clean lenses & fixtures; straighten, trim or prune around fixture if needed. - Check timer & photo cell; reset timer for seasonal hours if needed. - Verify transformer operation to insure system integrity is within proper voltage range for wattage output.
<u>Labor Rate:</u>	If repairs are needed at the <u>time of inspection</u> , they will be done on a time and material basis, with a 10% discount. Payment is due upon completion of service. If service is needed between semi-annual check-up, a standard trip and labor charge will apply, with a 10% discount.
Maintenance	\$199.00 for 12 fixture system or less Add \$10.00 for each additional fixture over 12 \$199.00 + (\$10 xfixtures over 12) = Total Cost Any fixture needing a ladder to inspect may require 2 men for safety & an additional charge may apply. Please call for cost.
