

BVNW Bandwagon Meeting Minutes

Tuesday March 3rd, 2020

7:00 pm in the Band room

Welcome/Call to Order – The meeting was called to order at 7:02 by Kelly Winkler.

January 2020 Minutes - Krystal Robinson made a motion and Sharon Murdock seconded to approve the minutes which were approved.

Committee Chair Reports

a.) Treasurer Report--- Kristi Taylor

Fee collection – We are ahead of budget on fees. However, 16 payments are outstanding and we are working on collecting those.

Update on expenses –

- BDJB shirts were purchased,
- DawgHouse tshirts were purchased.
- We incurred entry fees and clinician fees for jazz festivals,
- Future Husky tshirts were purchased. We typically sell 30-40 a year and any remaining inventory is carried over. Shirts purchased this year were to fill in sizes we were low on.
- Scholarships to drum majors are paid for them to attend a camp. One has been paid out so far this year.
- We will incur expenses for instrumentation scholarship.
- Website has had minimal fees and will be approximately \$20 more. This year was light – expense is usually paid for a two year hosting so will be higher next year.
- Show rights and percussion music – We have purchased two new marching snare drums, new marching band grade racks for our mallet instruments utilizing this budget. The new racks allows for mounting which will minimize the process of getting on and off the field. The directors applied for a grant for this from the PBC and received \$8,000. The Bandwagon utilized funds from show rights and percussion line to complete this purchase, \$426.

c.) Uniforms—Jen Stambaugh, Betsy Waxman, Linda Stark No report.

d.) Locker Decorations --- No report.

e.) Roadies – No report. Neither Roadie Chairs are returning for next year. Paul Nobrega indicated that he will help but would like to be in a transitional role. He is probably best positioned to help identify someone to take over this position.

f.) Feed the Band--- Kris and Matt Quick - Pizza has been ordered for the BVNW Area Band Festival.

g.) Senior Recognition Night --- Michelle Tribbey & Kendall Burr – Would like to know if Karen will print the pictures or if they should. Karen will print. Three kids did not have a picture taken at senior night. Karen will try to obtain a picture but if unable, they will receive the frame only.

h.) Chaperones Captain --- Linda Stark – no report.

- i.) Band Gala --- Karen Henderson – Planning going forward as expected.
- a. Many volunteers are filling the same role they had last year.
 - b. Jalene Lambert is taking over the senior collage, and is working with Hannah Barlows.
 - c. For the slide show, Karen secured access to the formal band pictures and they were provided at no charge (we were allowed to download). Although we may only have marching students. Sharon Murdock will follow up to see if we can have access to the photos from the other bands to obtain the other students.
 - d. Color guard photos need to be obtained.
 - e. Karen would like to request Color guard students contribute specifically for their director gifts. Adam will send email directly to those students.
 - f. Decorations, food, slide show, etc are all being worked on.
 - g. Will request volunteers for set up and tear down at some point in future.
 - h. April 27 is date.
 - i. Karen provided an update on expenditures to provide info for the upcoming budget meeting:
 - i. Current year budgeted \$1500 for food, spent \$1800 last year – used feed the band money.
 - ii. Decorations budget is set at \$300 should be \$500.
 - iii. Senior gifts-suggest \$10 per kid. Budget has been too tight. \$360 in frames, \$1 per picture. Her labor for engraving – probably won't offer to do this again next year. Priced it out of the building and it was \$18 per frame.
 - iv. Plaques and engraving - \$800.
 - v. Programs \$142. (sometimes we are charged and sometimes not – suggest \$150)
- l. Karen is willing to chair again next year but would like someone else to handle senior gifts which used to have a separate chair.
- j.) Care/Concern---No report. Adam and Melissa said they have worked with the chair and a few needs have been addressed.

Already ahead of prior years in planning for the show, so should have color guard uniforms selected by that date. This will also will help allow freshman to transition well.

Nominating committee – We need to replace Secretary and Vice Presidents for next year. Bylaws suggest a nominating committee of three people. The Presidents will fulfill the role of the nominating committee if no one is interested. Please submit names of people who may be interested in filling the open positions to the Presidents.
