

PIMLICO DEMOLITION PLANS



Read about impact on the Park Heights neighborhood



The long-planned demolition of the Pimlico racetrack will begin soon after next week's Preakness Stakes. Next year's Preakness will take place at the Laurel Park racetrack. Preakness returns to Pimlico in 2027. The new, \$400 million state-funded horse racing facility is expected to support about 500 jobs and become a year-round hub of economic activity, MSA leaders said.

The renovation will make Pimlico the permanent home of Maryland thoroughbred racing and will allow the facility to host more than 100 racing days each year. It currently hosts about 15 yearly. Aside from making Pimlico a world-class race track, there will be a hotel, event space, and other amenities.




