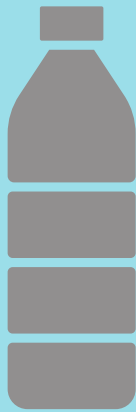
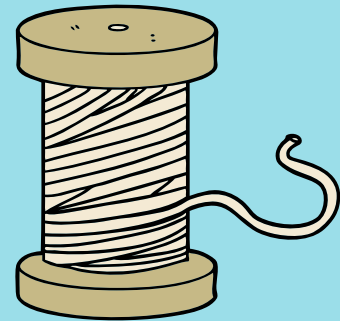


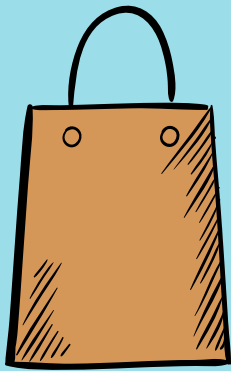
DIY Bee Hotel



Empty plastic bottle



Twine



Paper bag

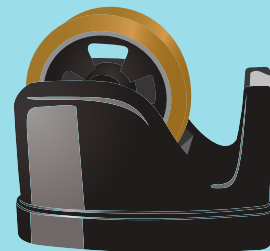
What you need



Scissors



Pencil



Tape

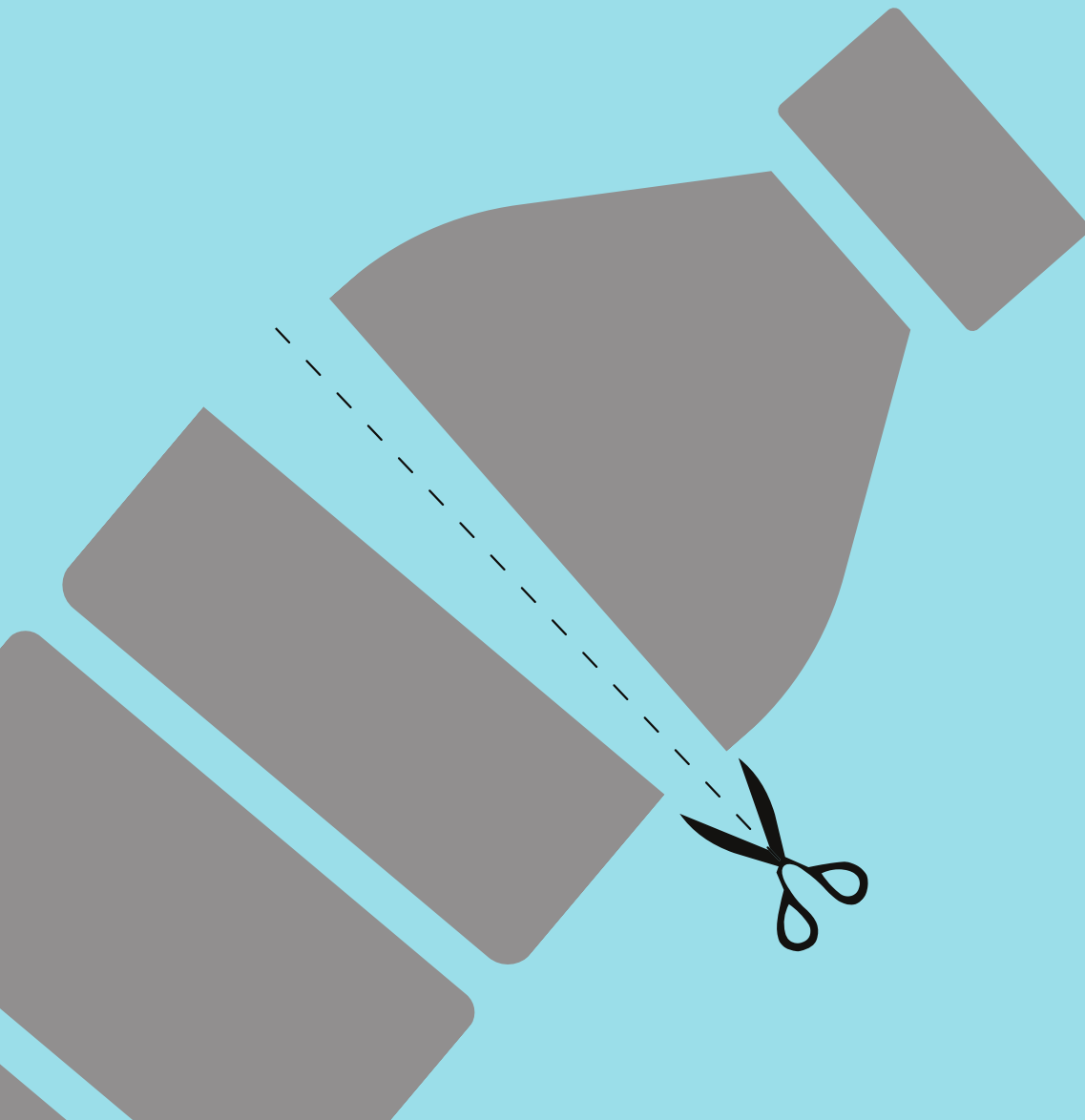
Step 1



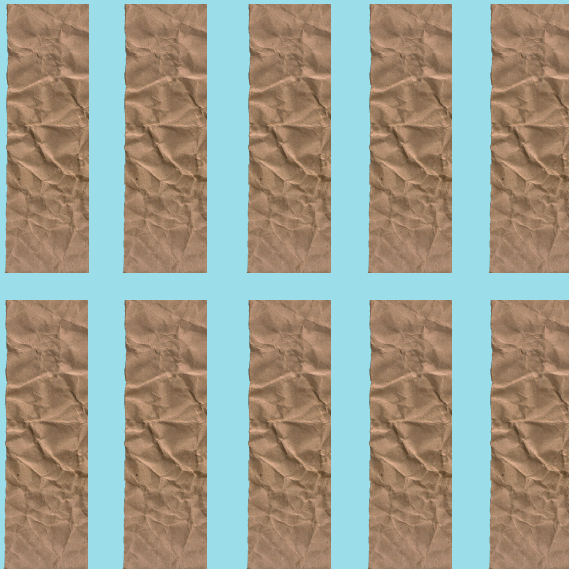
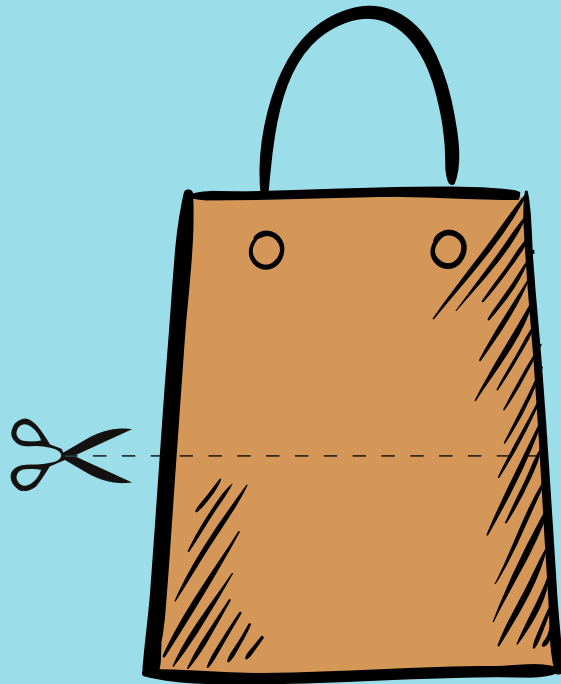
Start by carefully cutting off the top portion of the bottle (please have an adult do this part!)



This project is a good way to recycle household plastic



Step 2



Next, cut approximately (25) 6" x 2" rectangles from your paper bag

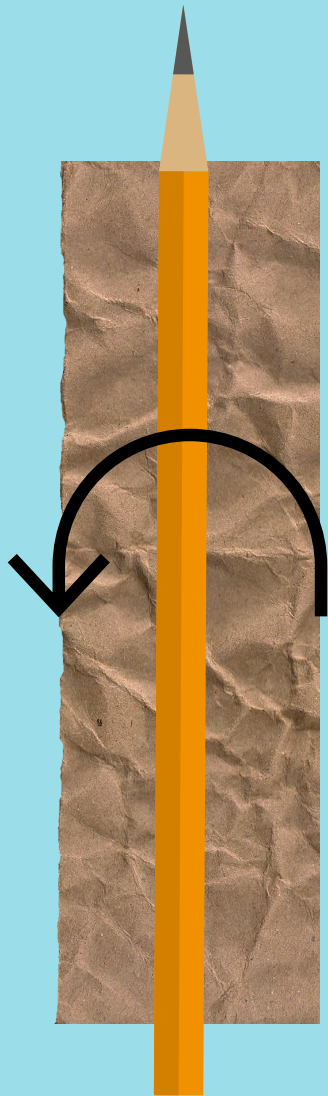


All rectangles do not have to be perfect so have fun cutting out all different sizes

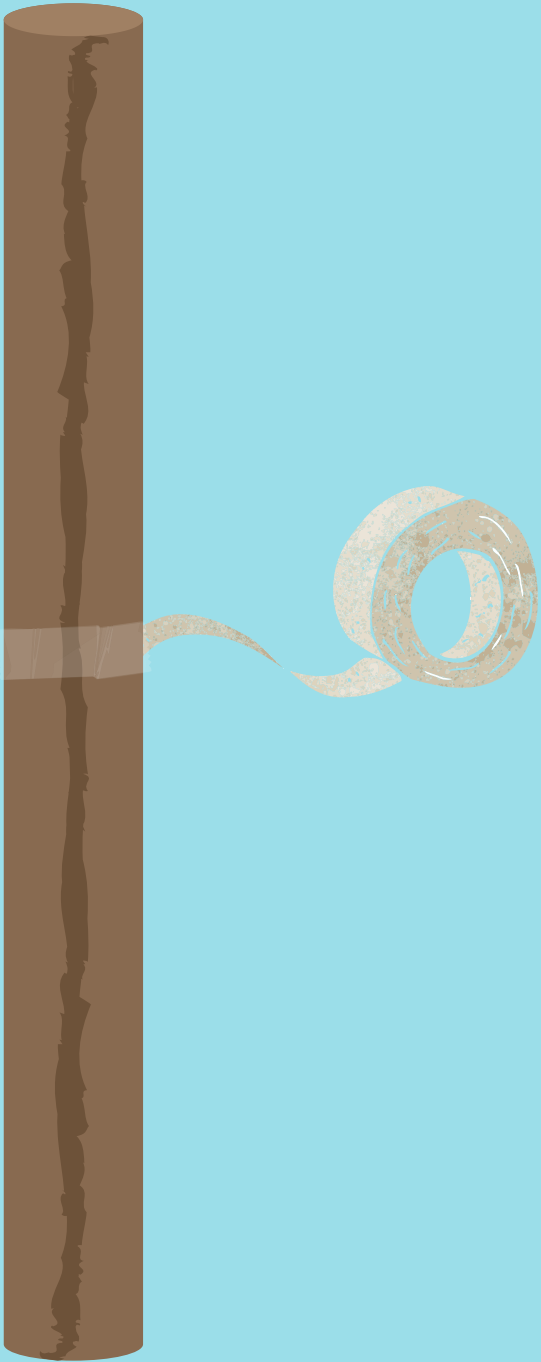
Step 3



Take your cut out rectangles and wrap them around a pencil, making a straw shape



Step 4



Secure the straw shapes by adding a piece of tape



Use ecologically sustainable tape and a recycled paper bag if possible

Step 5

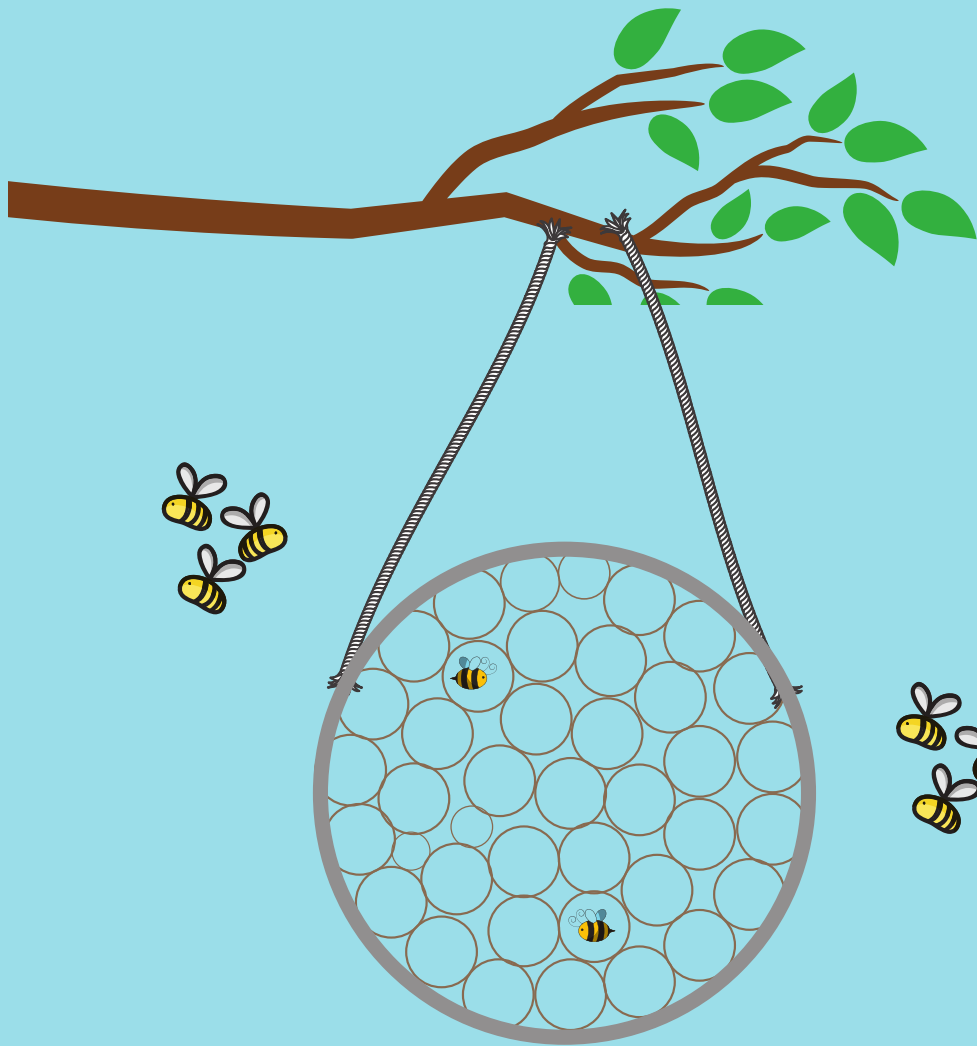


Take your rolled and taped pieces of paper and place them in your cut bottle, do this until the bottle is full



You can make the paper snug together, but make sure to leave enough room for your bees to fit as these will be their hotel rooms!

Step 6



Now that your bottle is full of little paper straw shapes, use your twine and wrap it around the bottle



Simply hang it from a tree and watch your bee guests as they check in and out of your hotel!
