- Founded: in 1978 as a research center to create a world without war
- Size: ~330 acres
- Population: ~160 residents + 300-400 visitors during events
- Tamera is one of Europe's oldest and most visionary ecovillages, guided by the belief that global peace begins with healing human relationships and living in harmony with nature

Sustainability Highlights

- Water Retention Landscape: Tamera transformed arid land into a lush ecosystem using permaculture principles, building lakes and swales
- Energy Systems: Solar panels and compost-generated biogas, research to replace batteries with natural energy storage solutions
- Food Production: Self-sufficient in vegetables and fruits, planting to prevent forest fires and reduce groundwater consumption
- Architecture: Eco construction using local and sustainable materials
- Communal Spaces: Designed to foster connection and learning

Governance Structure

- Communitarian ownership, involving 2 associations that own equal shares, each person is part of one of the associations
- This means that each person collectively owns the property and infrastructure, no one can sell, buy or transfer shares
- The business side of Tamera (governed as a not-for-profit social enterprise), owns the property and infrastructure and takes care of maintenance, planning, licensing, etc.
