### What is a steering committee?

A steering committee is a group of 3 or more people who are current members of LIRID. They will take over the organization when board positions are vacant.

## What does a steering committee do?

The steering committee is responsible for:

- Housekeeping (pay bills, collect mail)
- Submit required paperwork to RID three times a year
- Oversee committees
- Hold general meetings two times a year (virtually or in person)
- Meet as needed to discuss the chapter (
- Organize and run elections for a new board when there is member interest

### Who can be on the steering committee?

Members of the steering committee can be any LIRID member with interest.

# How is this different from being a board member?

- Certification or previous LIRID membership is not required to be on the steering committee.
- Steering committee will *not* participate in Regional conference calls.
- LIRID will not have a seat on the President's Council and will not have representation at the National level under a steering committee.
