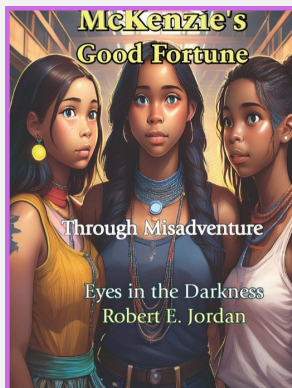
### THE ESCALATING WAR OF WORDS

We are all familiar with the adage that “the squeaky wheel that gets the grease,” and indeed, it is a volume that gets the attention of an audience, whether intended or not. To overpower an opponent through vociferous rants seems to be the standard of the day. But there is a difference between what is said and what is heard. And, different people hear different parts of speech, which, of course, is at times troubling. Lewis Carroll impressed upon his readers that “you should say what you mean and mean what you say!” Yet, today, often what is said is stated to inflict a point of view that is sharp and cuts to the heart of the matter. The principled debate has long since degenerated into personal attacks and mudslinging, focusing on humiliating an opponent through supposition and speculation, and, with an uptick in tone, rudeness, and obscenity. Tolerance has been supplanted by small-mindedness, and spirited discussion superseded by vulgarity and crudity. It has also been said, “History repeats itself.” I believe this is true, as the current political tone is reminiscent of the late 1960s. In fact, I see social, racial, and political similarities today that were also present during the run-ups to the 1968 presidential elections. Protesters, malcontents, and anarchists shout their agendas with contempt while the disenfranchised follow, as a growing mob seizes the opportunity to turn frustrations into acts of violence. However, their message is lost, as opposing sides are infused into a volatile environment. Like lint on a fine suit, it is the fringe that is noticed most during such times as these. These are troubling times indeed. Focusing internally, however, would lead to isolationism, so we must also focus on world events as once-veiled threats are today proclaimed as outright challenges to our national objectives and global security.
