**Horse of the Americas, Inc.
Farm & Ranch Work Award Form**

Definition: This award is given to acknowledge the accomplishments of the Spanish Mustang as a working or using horse. Examples: packing, riding fence, cattle drives and roundups, use as a lesson horse, marking trails for competitive/endurance rides, etc.

1. Horses must be registered with Horse of the Americas, Inc. during the entire point season for which points are submitted. If more than one horse is ridden, make a sheet for each horse.
2. The owner of the horse must be an up-to-date member of the organization and any points earned during a period in which the owner is not a member will not be utilized in the compilation of points for the season.
3. The person named as the owner on the point form must be the person who is named as owner on the horse's registration per official HOA records.
4. Riders do not need to be members of the organization.
5. The horse must be performing work. Pleasure rides are recorded on a separate form.
6. Training activities will not be considered for this award.
7. The Farm and Ranch Award will be presented to any HOA registered horse earning 75 points in a year. Points may be accumulated over the lifetime of the horse. Points may be earned towards Buckaroo, Sundance, Legends, and Corazon Awards.
8. One point will be earned for each day of work. A minimum of one hour must be done on each day. If hours exceed five in one day, one additional point will be earned.
9. Miles are automatically included in the mileage program. To convert hours ridden, use a 1 to 3 ratio. (1 hour = 3 miles at a walk)

Figuring Points: Example: 5.6 miles x .2 = 1.12 hours x 2 = 2.24 points
