**Horse of the Americas, Inc.
Individual Trail Riding**

Definition: This award is given for promoting Colonial Spanish Horses by participation in individual rides.

- 1) Horses must be registered with Horse of the Americas, Inc. during the entire point season for which points are submitted. If more than one horse is ridden, make a sheet for each horse.
- 2) The owner of the horse must be a current member of the organization and any points earned during a period in which the owner is not a member will not be utilized in the compilation of points for the season.
- 3) The person named as the owner on the point form must be the person who is named as owner on the horse's registration per official HOA records.
- 4) Riders do not need to be members of the organization.
- 5) Points may be earned towards Buckaroo, Sundance, Legends, and Corazon Awards.
- 6) One point will be earned for each individual ride.
- 7) Each ride must be on public or private trails accessible and at least five miles in length.
- 8) Each ride must be for pleasure. Working situations, such as herding cattle or riding fence, are covered under the Farm and Ranch Work Award.
- 9) Miles are automatically included in the mileage program. To convert hours ridden, use a 1 to 3 ratio. (1 hour = 3 miles at a walk)

10) Figuring Points: Example: 5.6 miles x .2 = 1.12 hours x 2 = 2.24 points
