**Horse of the Americas, Inc.
Working Equitation Award**

Definition: A horse shown in judged classes that have levels of difficulty such as reining, cutting, pleasure, combined training events, trail obstacle classes, trail challenge, working equitation, etc. Horses perform solo in a ring, arena, or cross-country course.

- 1) Horses must be registered with Horse of the Americas, Inc. during the entire point season for which points are submitted. If more than one horse is ridden, make a sheet for each horse.
- 2) The **owner of the horse** must be a current member of the organization and any points earned during a period in which the owner is not a member will not be utilized in the compilation of points for the season.
- 3) The person named as the owner on the point form must be the person who is named as owner on the horse's registration per HOA records. Riders do not need to be members of the organization.
- 4) Points may be earned towards Buckaroo (Youth—50 pts), Sundance (300 points), Legends (500 points), and Corazon Awards, (1,000 points).
- 5) Points are based on the number of entries per class as follows:
