



Horse of the Americas, Inc. Pleasure Trail Rides & Pleasure Driving

Definition: This award is given for promoting Colonial Spanish Horses by participation in group rides, which may be organized within a neighborhood, or by various equestrian groups.

- 1) Horses must be registered with Horse of the Americas, Inc. during the entire point season for which points are submitted. If more than one horse is ridden, make a sheet for each horse.
- 2) The owner of the horse must be a current member of the organization and any points earned during a period in which the owner is not a member will not be utilized in the compilation of points for the season.
- 3) The person named as the owner on the point form must be the person who is named as owner on the horse's registration per official HOA records. Riders/Drivers do not need to be members of the organization.
- 4) Points may be earned towards Buckaroo, Sundance, Legends, and Corazon Awards.
- 5) One point will be earned for each individual ride; three points will be earned for group rides in which three or more riders participate. If more than 50 riders participate, one additional point will be earned.
- 6) Each ride/drive must be on public or private trails accessible and at least five miles in length.
- 7) Each ride/drive must be for pleasure. Working situations, such as herding cattle or riding fence, are covered under the Farm and Ranch Work Award.
- 8) Miles are automatically included in the mileage program. To convert hours ridden, use a 1 to 3 ratio. (1 hour = 3 miles at a walk)
- 9) The Pleasure Trail Riding/Driving Award will be presented to any horse that earns 50 points. Points may be accumulated over the lifetime of the horse.
