

Horse of the Americas, Inc. Speed Events Award

Definition: A horse ridden in gymkhana and play day events with the outcome determined by electronic timer or other means of timing and/or elimination. These are not judged events. Examples: Backfiring the Prairie, Keyhole Race, Barrel Race, Pole Bending, Flag Race, Cherokee Ribbon Race, Forest Escape Race, etc.

- 1) Horses must be registered with the Horse of the Americas, Inc. during the entire point season for which points are submitted If more than one horse is ridden, make a sheet for each horse.
- 2) The owner of the horse must be an up-to-date member of the organization and any points earned during a period in which the owner is not a member will not be utilized in the compilation of points for the season.
- 3) The person named as the owner on the point form must be the person who is named as owner on the horse's registration per official HOA records.
- 4) Riders do not need to be members of the organization.
- 5) Points may be earned towards Buckaroo, Sundance, Legends, and Corazon Awards.
- 6) Points are based on the number of entries per class as follows:
