



**Horse of the Americas, Inc.
Western Performance Award**

Definition: A horse shown in judged classes that have levels of difficulty such as reining, cutting, pleasure, combined training events, trail obstacle classes, trail challenge, working equitation, etc. Horses perform solo in a ring, arena, or cross-country course.

- 1) Horses must be registered with Horse of the Americas, Inc. during the entire point season for which points are submitted. If more than one horse is ridden, make a sheet for each horse.
- 2) The owner of the horse must be a current member of the organization and any points earned during a period in which the owner is not a member will not be utilized in the compilation of points for the season.
- 3) The person named as the owner on the point form must be the person who is named as owner on the horse's registration per HOA records. Riders/Drivers do not need to be members of the organization.
- 4) Points may be earned towards Buckaroo, Sundance, Legends, and Corazon Awards.
- 5) Points are based on the number of entries per class as follows:
