The BRCTM scholarship is administered according to the following guidelines:

- 1. The student intends to pursue a career in the teaching of mathematics. She/he will attend a four-year private or state supported college/university in Virginia.
- High school transcripts, letters of recommendation, honors and awards, school and community activities, test scores, and written expression will be considered in the selection process. Finalists may be invited to a personal interview with a committee of members of the Blue Ridge Council of Teachers of Mathematics.
- 3. The scholarship grant will be sent directly to the college/university indicated by the recipient to offset tuition and related costs.
- 4. The student must maintain a 3.0 (4.0 scale) overall GPA and a 2.8 average in all mathematics courses.
- 5. The scholarship may be renewed for up to four consecutive years, provided that the student remains in good academic standing and is making progress toward licensure in mathematics education. It is the responsibility of the student to contact BRCTM each year to renew the scholarship.
