How to Register

- 1. Visit the Membership page on the Badminton Ontario website <u>https://www.badmintonontario.ca/membership/</u>
- 2. Review the membership categories and determine which one is right for you
- 3. Click on the red 'Purchase' button to be taken to the Badminton Canada Tournament Software homepage.
 - For current and past members, log in using your existing login credentials. If you are having trouble logging in, please use the 'Lost your password?' or 'Lost your login name?' options.
 - For new members, please create an account by clicking the 'Sign Up' button.
- 4. Follow the registration/renewal prompts in the Tournament Software portal. Please make sure to keep all personal and contact information up to date.
- 5. Submit your registration/renewal and provide your payment information when prompted to complete your membership registration.

Upgrades – Members can "upgrade" their memberships at any point during the season if they wish to change membership categories (e.g. from a General Membership to a competitive membership OR from one competitive membership to another). This can be done by selecting the 'upgrade' button directly in your Tournament Software account.

Affiliate Membership

All players (recreational or competitive), coaches (volunteer or paid), administrators & managers (volunteer or paid), and officials who are registered as part of a Badminton Ontario affiliated club, team, or program are considered to be BON Affiliate Members.

Affiliate Members may also choose to purchase BON General Memberships and any of our competitive memberships if they wish to access the designated tournaments, events, programs, services, and benefits of those membership types.

Recreational, Club, and Drop-in Players

Recreational or drop-in players who play and participate at the local level (within their own clubs and districts), but who otherwise do not participate in Badminton Ontario tournaments and events, are <u>not</u> required to be BON General Members, and may remain as Affiliate Members so long as their club is affiliated and in good standing with Badminton Ontario and their respective District Association.

Recreational players who are part of a club that is not Badminton Ontario or District affiliated must purchase a BON General Membership if they wish to access any of BON's events, programs, services, and membership benefits.

Independent Players and Non-Affiliated Club Players

- 1. If you are an independent competitive player who is <u>not</u> a member of a Badminton Ontario affiliated club, you <u>must</u> register and compete as an 'Independent'. Every District Association has an 'Independent' option in the clubs listing when registering in Tournament Software.
- 2. If you are a recreational player at a non-Badminton Ontario affiliated club, you <u>must</u> purchase a BON General Membership for the season in order to take advantage of our member benefits and access BON programs, services, and events.
- 3. If you are a competitive player at a non-Badminton Ontario affiliated club, you must register and compete as an 'Independent'. Every District Association has an 'Independent' option in the clubs listing when you register in Tournament Software.
