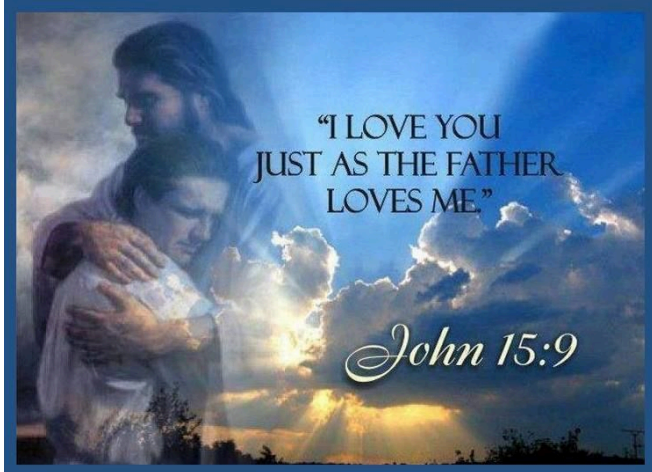

GOSPEL : John 15:9-17



In today's Gospel, Jesus teaches the disciples to obey his commandment of love just as he obeyed his Heavenly Father's will and remain inseparably bonded with Him. Jesus' unconditional, forgiving, selfless, sacrificial love for us must be the criterion of our love for others. The highest expression of this love is our willingness to lay down our lives as Jesus did, for people who don't deserve it. The result of our abiding in love, in God, will be perfect joy. Jesus no longer calls us slaves but now calls us "friends." He tells us that he has chosen us, and that, if we use his name, we can ask the Father for anything and it will be granted.
