First Sunday of Advent 01 December 2024

Gospel Luke 21:25-28,34-36



Advent is a time of waiting and hoping, of renewing our trust in God's merciful love and care, and of reflecting on the several comings (advents), of Christ into our lives.

In today's Gospel (Lk 21:25–28, 34–36), Jesus prophesies the signs and portents that will accompany the end of the present world of matter, space, and time with His Second Coming in glory as our Judge to give us the rewards of our lives. Jesus encourages us to be expectant, optimistic, vigilant, and well-prepared: "When these signs begin to happen, stand erect and raise your heads because your redemption is at hand" (Lk 21:28). Jesus wants us to face the future with confidence in God's providence.

We need to prepare ourselves for Christ's Second Coming by allowing Jesus to be reborn daily in our lives. Advent gives us time to make this preparation by repenting of our sins, by renewing our lives through prayer and penance, and by sharing our blessings with others. Advent also provides an opportunity for us to check for what needs to be put right in our lives, to see how we have failed, and to assess the ways in which we can do better. Let us accept the challenge of the German mystic Angelus Silesius "Christ could be born a thousand times in Bethlehem - but all in vain until He is born in me." Jesus must be reborn in our hearts and lives, during this season of Advent and every day of our lives, in our love, kindness, mercy, and forgiveness.


