SUNDAY 11th July 2021 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year B)

Gospel.: Mk 6:1-13

The Gospel today tells the story of Jesus' commissioning of the twelve apostles to preach the "Good News" of repentance, forgiveness of sins, liberation, and salvation through Jesus. Just as God sent the prophet Amos to preach repentance to ancient Israel and St. Paul to preach the Good News of salvation to the Gentiles, so Jesus sends forth the Twelve to proclaim the Good News of God's Kingdom and to bring healing to those who are sick. The Gospel reports the instruction Jesus gave the apostles for their first mission. They are illustrations of God's love and providence in action.

As Christian we are called like the Apostles to proclaim the Truth to the world, and this obviously involves a risk of rejection. That is the rejection that Amos and the other Old Testament prophets faced, and that is the rejection that Jesus has spoken about in today's Gospel Reading and accepted as the price of His Self-offering on Calvary.
