SUNDAY 28th November 2021 1st Sunday of Advent Year C

GOSPEL Luke 21:25-28, 34-36

Advent is a time of waiting for Christ. Besides coming into our world through birth, Jesus comes into our lives as we live them through His Church, the Sacraments (especially the Eucharist), the Word of God, the worshipping community, as we die, and finally, in His Second Coming

In today's Gospel, Jesus prophesies the signs and portents that will accompany his Second Coming and encourages us to be expectant, optimistic, vigilant, and well-prepared: "When these signs begin to happen, stand erect and raise your heads because your redemption is at hand" (Luke 21:28). Jesus wants us to face the future with confidence in God's providence.

Life messages: We need to prepare ourselves for Christ's second coming by allowing Jesus to be reborn daily in our lives. Advent gives us time to make this preparation — repenting of and confessing our sins, renewing our lives through prayer and penance, and sharing our blessings with others. In Advent, we also need to check for what needs to be put right in our lives, to see how we have failed, and to assess the ways in which we can do better. Let us accept the challenge of the German mystic Angelus Silesius "Christ could be born a thousand times in Bethlehem – but all in vain until He is born in me."
