Fouth Sunday of Easter, May 11, 2025

Readingd Acts 13:14, 43-52; Rv 7:9, 14b-17; Jn 10:27-30

Jesus is the good Shepherd.



The Fourth Sunday of Easter, known as Good Shepherd Sunday, is also the "World Day of Prayer for Vocations." Each year on this Sunday, we reflect on the image of Jesus as the Good Shepherd, devotedly and kindly taking care of his flock.

Scripture lessons summarized:

Today's first reading describes how Paul and Barnabas opted to listen to the voice of Jesus, the Good Shepherd and followed him. They suffered like Jesus; rebuffed and rejected by many when they tried to share the good news of salvation.

The second reading, taken from the Book of Revelation, depicts Jesus as both the glorified Lamb and the Shepherd. John's vision encourages his readers with the assurance that every person who has ever followed Christ and led others to him will share everlasting life with him.

The Gospel text offers us both comfort and a great challenge. The comforting message is that Jesus says that no one can snatch the sheep out of His Father's hands. The challenge is that pastors should be good shepherds to those entrusted to their care, while their flock of lay people should respond by being good sheep.

LIFE MESSAGE

Let us become good shepherds and good sheep, good leaders and good followers.

1) Let us become good shepherds: Everyone who is entrusted with the care of others is a shepherd. Hence, pastors, parents, teachers, doctors, nurses, government officials, etc. are all shepherds. We become good shepherds by loving those entrusted to us, praying for them, spending our time and talents for their welfare, and guarding them from physical and spiritual dangers.

2) Let us be good sheep in the fold of Jesus, the Good Shepherd: Our local parish is our sheepfold, and our pastors are our shepherds. Let us receive the spiritual food our pastors provide by regular participation in the Holy Mass, by frequenting the Sacraments, and by attending prayer services, renewal programs, and missions.
