

The Hebrew Name- DANI-EL means- **“GOD is my JUDGE”**-
The Word- DIN means to JUDGE. EL means GOD (DIN-EL).

Daniel lived about 620 BC to after his last vision (530 BC) (to about 94 years old).

The 606 BC siege of Judah caused 70 Years of the Hebrews’ Exile into Babylon (606-536. BC- Jer. 25: 11). (Dan. 1-2). DANIEL was re-named BELTESHAZZAR)- (Dan.1:7) “BEL- the keeper of secrets” & States-man, was Author of the Book- at a mature age. (Dan.9:2). He was of King DAVID’S Royalty & interpreter of Dreams, who “X-rayed Time & Surveyed Kingdoms” along the Geo-Prophetic Highway (Dan. 2).*

DANIEL interpreted King Nebuchadnezzar’s Dream & **the King Worshiped Him** (Dan.2:46), (36-49). He Declared: “The KINGDOM OF GOD”.. (Rev. 11:15). JESUS CHRIST (Ambassador) acknowledged & Honored **“DANIEL the Prophet”**, (Matt. 24: 15-16). Ezekel called DANIEL “Wise” (28:3). The Weeping Jeremiah bore Prophetic Witness (Jer. 25: 11).

In 606 BC, DANIEL (age 14) & his Youthful friends were marched from Jerusalem to Babylon (over 600 hundred miles). Due to his exceptional Character, impeccable Wisdom & highest Educational Distinction in the OT Bible & Babylon, DANIEL (the “immortal Prophet”) was Appointed- Governor of Babylon by the dream-fearing King (Dan. 2: 48; 6:1-25). See Public Officers Official Character (NY EXC Law 132); NY Const. Art. 13, s.1; US Art. 6, s.2-3- (EXC & JUD)- Oath. Josephus the Historian confirmed that DANIEL was of Royal Heritage (an ageless & timeless Master of Architecture). In 536. BC, DANIEL Tamed a Den of Hungry Lions to which he & his Faithful companions were thrown (Dan. 6).
