### Topic: Creation

#### Week 1: PPM Unplugged

#### Week 2: God Created All Things

##### **Definition:**

Create: To bring something into existence.

##### **Discussion Questions:**

Who created the world and everything in it?

How did God create the world? How long?

Name some things God created.

##### **Scriptures:**

Genesis 1

This account goes on to describe the seven days of creation:

- in the beginning - God started creation
- the first day - light was created
- the second day - the sky was created
- the third day - dry land, seas, plants and trees were created
- the fourth day - the Sun, Moon and stars were created
- the fifth day - creatures that live in the sea and creatures that fly were created
- the sixth day - animals that live on the land and finally humans, made in the image of God were created
- by day seven - God finished his work of creation and rested, making the seventh day a special holy day.

**Activity:** Give each of the kids a piece of paper and a pencil. Take the kids outside to look at the world that, God, has created. Ask the kids to either write or draw a prayer to, God, in response to the wonderful world that He has created. (If the weather does not allow you to go outside you can look out of a window instead).

##### **Closing Thoughts:**

The question I want to ask you today is, Why do you think God made all those things? God wanted to make everything. Just like when you made your drawings that you told me about and

I made mine, God made what He made – people and animals and the whole world – because He wanted to. He created everything so that He could be proud of it and so that He could love it. God loves the world. He loves the mountains and the lakes and the animals, and He loves you. The Bible tells us that God even made you when you were still inside your mother's womb. He made you in there because He loves you and He wanted to make you.

### **Week 3: God Created Me**

#### **Definition:**

Unique: being the only one of its kind; unlike anything else.

**If God created us all to be unique, share one thing unique about you?**

**How does it make you feel to know that you are important to God?**
